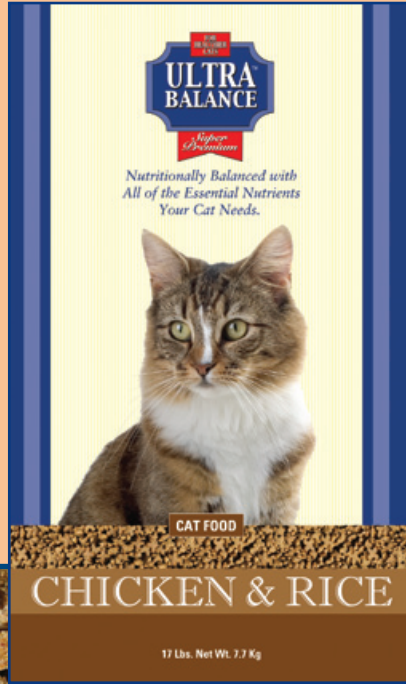


Cats and Kittens

3 to 4 weeks and up

Feeding Guidelines



Ultra Balance Cat Food is a complete, balanced cat food which is highly palatable and nutritious. It is formulated with good quality protein sources, including chicken meal and fish meal to promote lean body and strong muscles.

Adults

- Feed recommended amount of food daily. The adult cat may be fed the whole amount in one feeding or fed half in the morning and the other half in the evening. Make sure fresh water is provided at all times.

Kittens

- At 3-4 weeks of age, start feeding Ultra Balance Chicken and Rice Formula. Feed 4 times a day moistened with water. Kittens may be weaned between 6-8 weeks of age. At 4 months of age, the young cat can be fed as an adult.

10-14 lbs.	2/3-1 cup per day

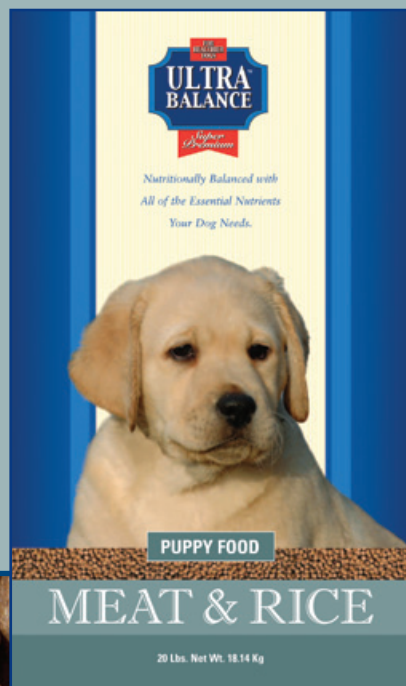

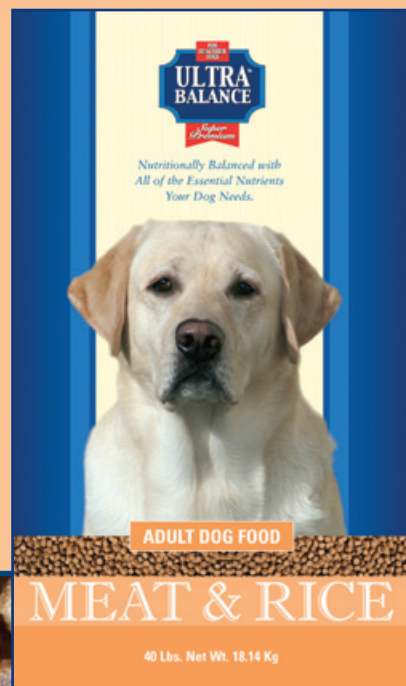

Up to 10 lbs.	1-2 1/2 cups per day
10-20 lbs.	2-3 1/2 cups per day
20-30 lbs.	2 1/2-4 1/2 cups per day
30-40 lbs.	3-5 1/2 cups per day
40-60 lbs.	4-6 1/2 cups per day

40-60 lbs.	2-3 1/2 cups per day
60-80 lbs.	2 1/2-4 1/2 cups per day
80-100 lbs.	3 1/2-6 cups per day

Feeding Instructions For Senior & Less Active

Dog's Weight (lbs)	Cups* Fed Per Day
Up to 10 lbs.	1/2-1 cups per day
10-20 lbs.	3/4-1 1/2 cups per day
20-30 lbs.	1-2 cups per day
30-40 lbs.	1 1/2-2 3/4 cups per day
40-60 lbs.	2-3 1/2 cups per day
60-80 lbs.	2 1/2-4 1/2 cups per day
80-100 lbs.	3 1/2-6 cups per day

Feeding Guidelines

Puppies

- Puppies will begin consuming solid foods around 4 weeks and will require more food and more meals.
- Feed up to 25% - 60% more kibble per pound of body weight compared to an adult.
- Feed at least 3 meals per day up to 3 to 6 months of age; 3 month old and younger puppies may require 4 meals per day.
 - From 8 - 20 weeks of age, puppies will be "cutting teeth"; the kibble should be moistened and feed smaller amounts with more daily meals; for example 3 meals per day.

Pregnant

- Length of pregnancy for most dog breeds is approximately 9 weeks or 56 - 64 days.
- Begin gradual increases of amount fed each day by week 5 & 6 of pregnancy.
- By week 7, increase amount of food by approximately 10% -15% above what she would be fed if she was not pregnant.
- By week 8 & 9, increase amount of food by 15%- 20% above what she would be fed if she was not pregnant.

Lactating

- The day the puppies are born (whelping), the nutritional requirements will increase by approximately 50% if compared to an inactive female that is not pregnant or lactating.
- Increase daily food up to 50% above the Feeding Guidelines; you should also consider feeding the daily amounts in at least 3 meals per day.

Active Dogs

- Dogs that are active may require more amounts of food than what is listed in the Feeding Guidelines; use the body condition scoring system to regulate body weight.
- Inactive Dogs or Maintenance Dogs that are inactive may require less amounts of food than what is listed in the Feeding Guidelines; use the body condition scoring system to regulate body weight.

AAFCO

- Meat & Rice Dog Food is formulated to meet the nutritional levels established by the American Association of Feed Control Officials (AAFCO) dog food nutrient profiles for all life stages.
