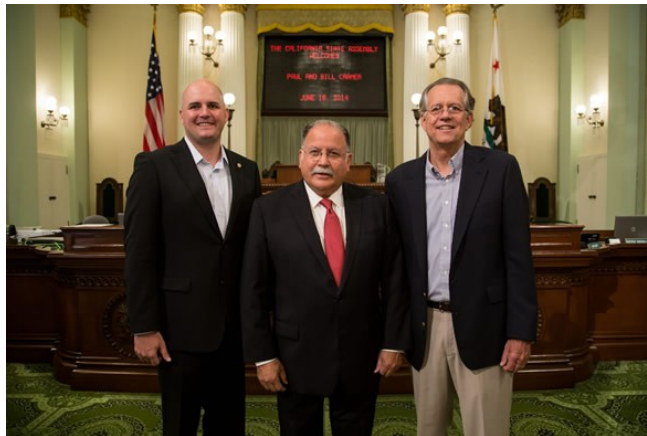


Assemblymember Medina Honors Star Milling Company as 2014 Small Business of the Year
