**FEEDING DIRECTIONS:** Herd Bucks - feed 1 to 2 lbs. per day in addition to roughage/hay portion of diet. Dry Does - feed 1/2 to 1 lb. per day in addition to roughage/hay source. Dry Pregnant does - feed up to 2 lbs. per day along with quality hay. Lactating Does - feed 2 to 6 lbs. per day depending on level of milk production along with quality hay. Make sure a supply of fresh clean drinking water is available at all times. Store in a cool, dry, ventilated location away from rodents and insects. Do not feed if moldy, spoiled, insect/rodent infested or has an uncharacteristic odor or appearance as it may cause illness or death.
